Head & Neck Cancer accounts for approximately 4% of all cancers in the United States. An estimated 53,000 people will be diagnosed with head & neck cancers each year, with an estimated mortality rate of 10,800.

Treatments can be intense, involving combinations of surgery, radiation therapy and chemotherapy. These patients often require assistance to help them complete treatments.
