- Entrusted to Newport Hospital by Elizabeth Prince of Newport and her children Guillaume de Ramel, Diana Oehrli, and Régis de Ramel



The Mission



Promote health and wellness among youth and families of Newport County.



Combat child and adolescent obesity through participation in physical activities.



Combat the abuse of alcohol and drugs.



Promote emotional and psychological well being of Newport County youth and their families.



Build confidence and a sense of achievement.



Purpose

To support the health of the community through innovation and athletic entrepreneurship.

Since it was established, the Frederick Henry Prince Memorial Fund at Newport Hospital has provided more than \$869,000 to programs across Newport County, including \$135,293 awarded to 25 programs in 2021.

Community programs funded by Powered by Prince are enjoyed by local Newport County children and youth, with activities ranging from biking, basketball, therapeutic sailing, hiking, and squash, to wrestling, field hockey, tennis, active pet care, and dance.



Proposal Application Process

- 1 Access proposal application information online from January 3, 2022 to January 31, 2022

- 2 Develop your proposal

Format Guidelines:

- 12-point font, single-spaced
- Include a cover sheet, project description/plan and financial plan
- Page limit = 3 pages for small projects (less than or equal to \$5,000.00)
- Page limit = 4 pages for large projects (greater than \$5,000.00)

- 3 Submit proposal (PDF version) **by January 31, 2022**, to fhpmemfund@lifespan.org

- 4 Proposals will be reviewed in February 2022

- 5 Funding awards will be announced in March 2022

- Endowments or other discretionary funding pools
- Multi-year requests
- Ticketed events such as fundraisers or dinners
- Political purposes or lobbying activities
- Debt reduction
- Projects unrelated to the Fund's mission
